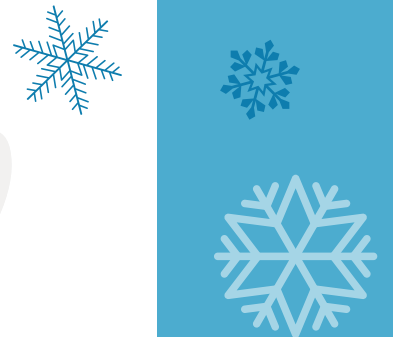


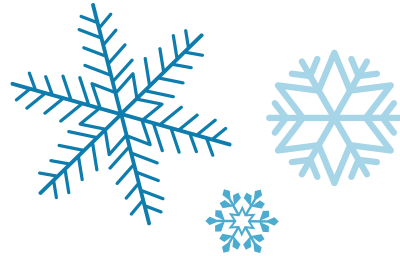
Winter Fun Packet

Winter Writing Prompts

(Hint: It has to do with the temperature of the oceans.) Can you think of other examples where this is the case? What are some activities you can do when the climate outside is cold?

Snow is falling, and school is closed for the day! Write a story about the best snow day ever.

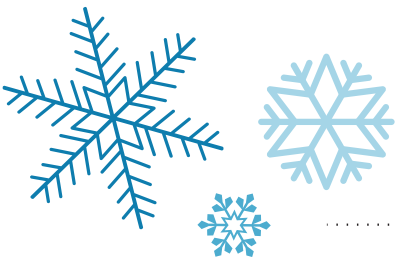

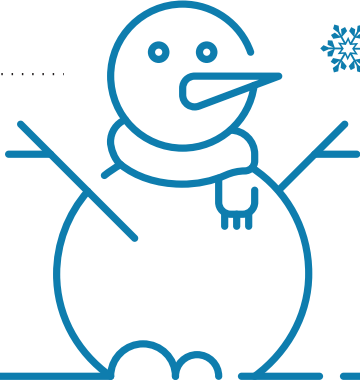

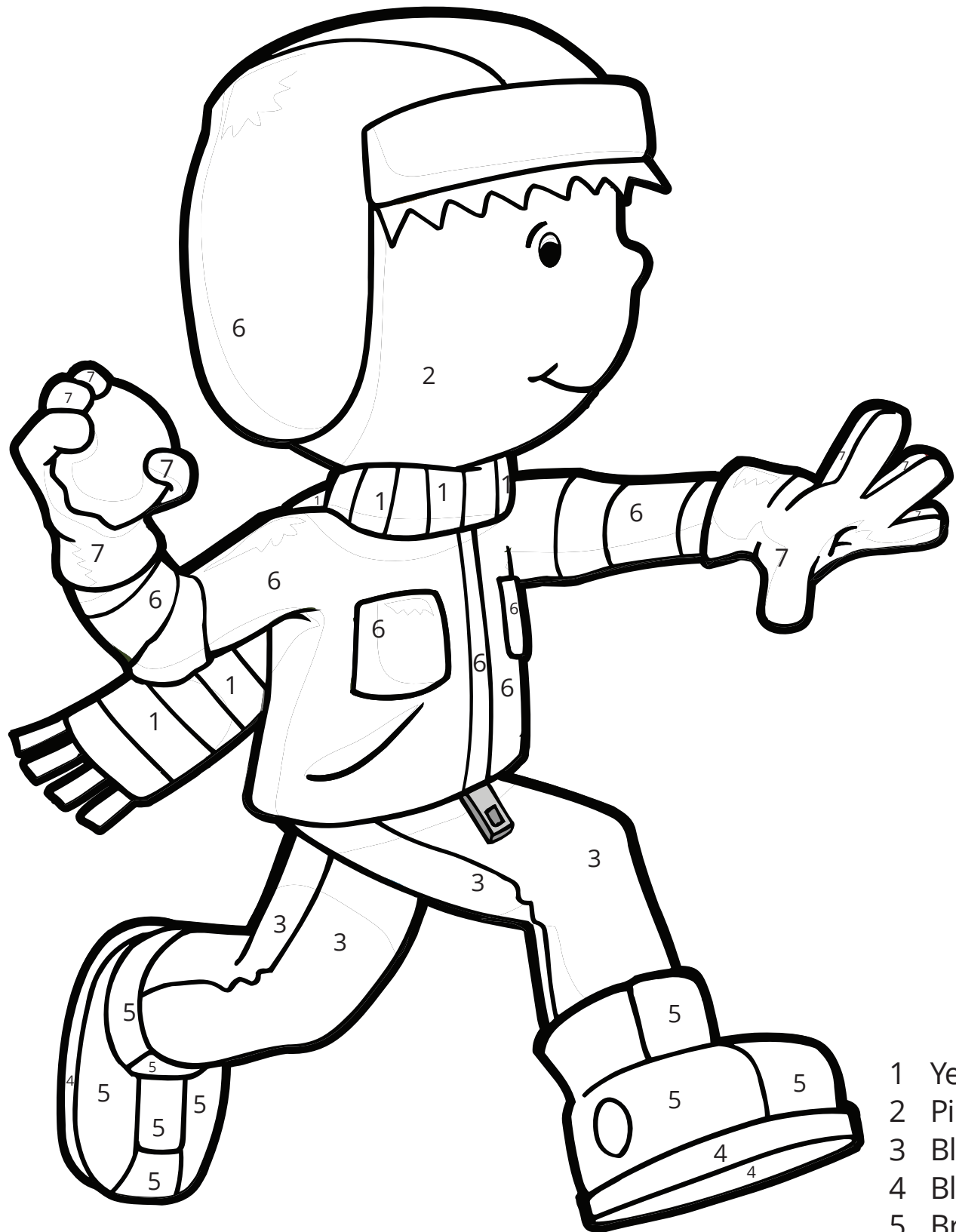
